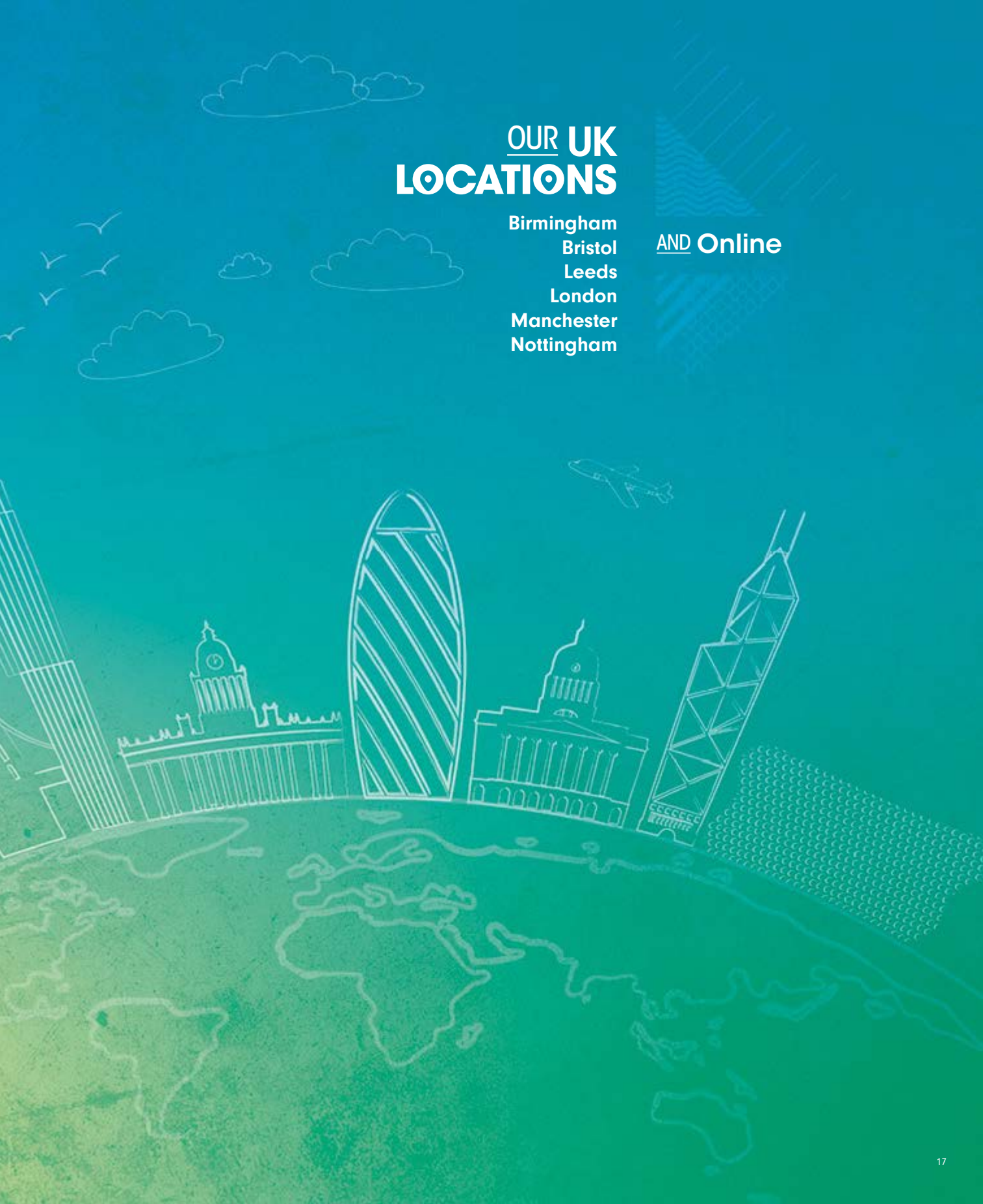

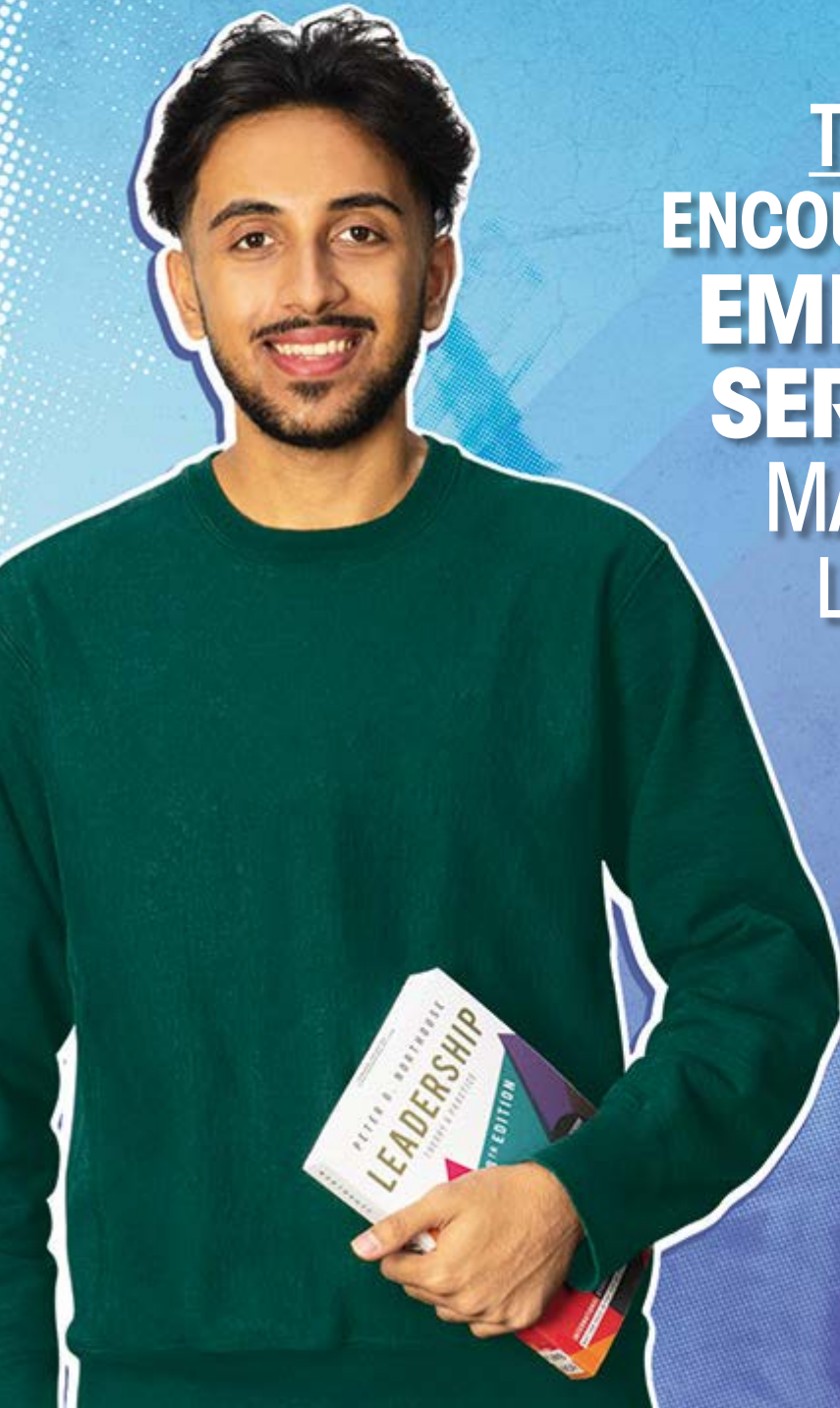

As Information Technology plays an increasingly important role in most sectors of business and society, Paul spends time being an active science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) Ambassador working with primary, secondary and post-16 education establishments talking about issues around cyber security, artificial intelligence, and robotics. His research focuses on the application of technology to solve some grand challenges, and he works collaboratively with colleagues from across these sectors.



OUR CRIMINOLOGY COURSES

OUR COURSES HAVE BEEN DESIGNED BY PRACTISING CRIMINOLOGISTS WITH EXTENSIVE EXPERIENCE IN BOTH ACADEMIC AND PRACTICAL ASPECTS OF THE STUDY OF CRIME, THE CAUSES OF CRIME, AND THE CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF CRIME.

As well as the BA Criminology, we also offer a BA in Criminology and Policing, which takes a critical criminology approach to the phenomena of crime and social harms in wider society. They cover a wide range of key contemporary and current issues and equip students to critically examine these areas from theoretical, empirical and practical perspectives and approaches.

RELEVANT TEACHING

Students will develop an understanding of criminological and sociological concepts and theories, and will use these to critically engage with a range of current issues. These include race, ethnicity and crime, gender and crime, the media and crime, globalization, and crime and key manifestations of crime such as illegal drug use, cybercrime, migration, environmental crime, social harms, mass incarceration, terrorism, trafficking, marginalisation, and criminalisation.

A CAREER IN **CRIMINOLOGY**

Our course is aimed at those looking to work in the broad criminal justice sector which offers a varied range of career pathways as well as connected sectors such as local authorities, NGOs and the Voluntary Sector.

Our BA (Hons) Criminology, and BA (Hons) in Criminology and Policing can lead to a wide variety of roles in the criminal justice sector and associated fields and encourages development of analytical, research and problem-solving skills which are in high demand by employers in many sectors.

MEET YOUR PROGRAMME & STUDENT LEAD LUKE HUBBARD

Luke worked for two years as a researcher at the Institute for Public Safety, Crime and Justice where he sought to translate empirical research findings into policy and practice across a range of criminal justice agencies, before undertaking a PhD. Luke's doctoral research explores the response of the criminal justice system, namely the police and probation service, to LGBT hate crime. During this time, he has also undertaken a range of other projects, whilst working as a researcher for GALOP, exploring the victimisation of LGBT people online and the needs and experiences of LGBT victims of crime.
